REPORTS

All 2019-2020 reports are to be sent through echelon. Even though the National Americanism & Civics program report forms have a deadline date of **June 30, 2020** all Department Americanism & Civics Chairs should submit their reports and compilations as soon as their Department Conventions have been concluded, to give the National Americanism & Civics Chair time to have the reports judged.

In addition to forwarding all lower echelons' forms, two reports are to be completed by the Department Americanism & Civics Chair:

1. A yearly report covering all Department-sponsored activities performed by the Department Board of Officers, Past Department Presidents, and Department Chairladies. **This is the DEPARTMENT as a Unit REPORT.**
2. A total of all Units' activities including the Department Board's activities (and, if from a region with a Chapter, the Chapter Board's Activities) are then to be made. **This second report is the COMPILED REPORT.**
